

11. Discussion Points

11a. SiS Flea Market

Background: To bridge the gap of supply and demand across our two flea markets (Intro & spring). Noor and Ludvig ask for a sum of money from KS to be used to buy items during the spring flea market, that can later be resold at the same price to the students on the Intro market. We believe if KS stands at the market it will also increase our visibility.

Discussion: A proposal of using the pant money for the flea market. Due to legal reasons we cannot use the pant money for this event.

We could use this opportunity to sell off the items we have occupying the storage rooms we by contract can not use. There is a concern that we would be selling useless stuff that has been rotting away but if it can be sold even after telling people the stories behind them then it should be fine. Another concern is once again the storage issue that we lack the capabilities to store stuff if we do buy it. This money will be from either intro or events budget within KS.

11b. Team Rynkeby Skaraborg Spin of Hope

Background: It is a wellness event and a fundraiser in support of the Swedish Childhood Cancer Fund, as well as a childhood cancer seminar. Experts from the Swedish Childhood Cancer Fund's research unit will participate, along with families from the Skaraborg group of the Swedish Childhood Cancer Fund. The idea is to make this a recurring Skaraborg event. It can be anything from a quiz walk or a fun run, they also said it's an opportunity to have an information table if we want to appear in person. Do we want to market this collectively in the student union? It will be on the 11 of April at Billingeus.

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Discussion: This event will most likely be favourable for us and them by this collaboration. For now it seems to be looked at in a positive light. Niklas will look into it.

Maybe not holding even more language cafés due to how many the school is already holding to oversaturate it. A monthly competition with teams where the winners could be advertised or just generally competitions. Ludvig will be able to hold one event on his own and any more than that and there will be project groups for the different events. We could use the kårkråkan to advertise a competition that could be on an interval. Ludvig will look into the competitions, while Maisie looks into the nordic wellness contract and Niklas will look into a collaboration with orbi on events such as these.

Even if we were to accept their former proposal from our former talks of 899kr for three months it still does not warrant exclusivity. Their current offer does not warrant exclusivity even if their gym is on campus, so we should also reach out to other gyms in the area to see if they can offer something better. We can also bring up the point that they are on campus and most of their members are students so it should be beneficial to them to offer something better our way.

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

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Feasibility and interest gauge for KS event Ideas

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1. Introduction

During the KS meeting 2026-02-26 the event chairman lifted different non-alcoholic activity ideas, put together by the event forum, as suggestions for a possible KS event. It was the board's decision that each idea in this document be looked into regarding metrics proposed by the event chairman, these metrics are:

Feasibility - Does the student union have money, the people, the locale to host this event?
(On a scale of 1 - 10)

Interest level - Roughly how interested do we think the students would be in this kind of event, measured by cost, event complexity, and how many similar events there are.
(On a scale of 1 - 10)

Once established the metrics will be added together to give an overall score for an idea, designated by ().

The events brought up to the meeting are the following: Game night, Board game night, bowling, Competitions (arts, etc), sports events (with HIFS). Tournaments, beach volleyball, outdoor event, language café with themes (Movies/Series, etc), movie nights, sleigh race (when there's snow), hike trip & treasure hunt.

This document will aim to give a rough summary of each activity's feasibility and perceived student interest.

2. Proposed Ideas

2.1. Game Night (15)

2.1.1. Feasibility 8

For a game night, a locale with a gaming console and a TV or compatible projector for the console is needed.

It would be possible to try and team with **Kappa bar**, however due to previous interaction with the business this is to be approached with caution.

Otherwise **KB** stands as a good option with their Stora Sal, however we'd need to find a console and controllers on our own.

Trean could also work and is the only locale option that does not sell alcohol.

The event would not need more than three people, one for helping guests get seated, one as judge, and one to help with technical problems. This could all easily be done by two people.

The main cost for this event would be the locale which can vary greatly, as well as the cost for personnel. However this could easily and cheaply be covered by ticket prices, depending on the size of the event.

2.1.2. Interest Level 7

I believe the interest level for this event would be hindered most by the ease for students to find alternatives to our event as there are a couple of dedicated game businesses. The activity is also rather niche focusing only on gamers and is only made more niche dependent on the chosen game for the night.

However I believe we could have a cheaper cost of entry with the same ease of participation if we stick to one game per event, this will cost us a couple of guests due to lack of freedom of choice regarding playable games.

2.2. Board Game Night (15)

2.2.1. Feasibility 8

For a board game night, a locale that can fit plenty of large tables and storage for board games would be needed.

Trean could work mostly due to Sugs presence with plenty of board games nearby and a decently large locale.

Manatorsk has a good sized locale in their basement and has been a previous partner of SiS, they've also got a couple of board games on hand.

KB's stora sal has very good space but no on hand board games.

For the event we'd need a couple of people knowledgeable in board games to help groups get started if they try something new or need help. We could guess to need at max five people.

The main cost would be the locale fee, and could easily get handled by ticket prices. Otherwise the cost for personnel could also be a large contributor.

2.2.2. Interest Level 7

As there is a large board game community already present in Skövde I believe the event has the potential to attract a lot of people however this is again hindered by the already existing businesses that provide similar services as our event would. Board games can also be quite niche.

It could also be difficult for guests to learn and try a new board game during the event which could lead to frustration if we can't help them. Possible guests might also be frightened to try the event if they don't know which games are on hand. Depending on the locale our inventory of possible board games can change drastically, the more we can have on hand the higher the chance for someone to attend.

The cost of entry is expected to be low and could definitely help attract more curious guests.

2.3. Bowling (12)

2.3.1. Feasibility 4

There's only two possible bowling locales in Skövde

Ten Lanes has 10 lanes with the cheapest cost of 215kr/hour monday - friday 11-17.

Due to how this event is forced to be structured we would not need more than two people to hold it.

This event's main cost will be tickets for the attendees. Due to the inherent high cost of tickets it'd be a high ticket price or cost for the student union to hold this event. It is highly advised to seek a partnership or student discount with these businesses.

2.3.2. Interest Level 8

There have not been many bowling events held by the student union and if we can get a hold of cheaper tickets than what's usually offered. The interest for this event would be high.

Bowling is a common free-time activity and it can be expected that each participant knows the rules and thus it'd be easy for them to participate. In the case of a large enough number of people that've never bowled we could group them together, forcing them to socialize.

The biggest hindrances for the attendance would be the cost of tickets and people not wanting to meet new people when bowling.

It's expected most people will attend on a Saturday however that's when it will cost the most so it's unclear.

2.4. Competitions & Tournaments (14) or (17)

2.4.1. Feasibility 6 or 9

Depending on the nature of the competitions we would either need a large locale to accommodate the activity or none at all.

For Most physical activities we could try to book **Boulogner Park**.

The event could easily be held online if we do competitions about. Art, Music, Poetry, Photography, etc.

Otherwise we'd need a locale for competitions about: sports

Depending on the competition the people needed could range from one to five. Mostly need people to be judges.

The cost of the event can also vary greatly, if held online the cost could be extremely low. If the event is a sports event/physical the cost will increase. The main expected cost will be locale and prizes.

2.4.2. Interest Level 8

In general most people enjoy competitions however this can vary depending on if they are group competitions or sole competitions.

The cost of entry will also be a large factor in how interested people will be in the event.

If we hold a competition it is very important that the rules and point system is made abundantly clear, to avoid backlash and uncertainty for the participants.

If we add a prize to the competition the interest level would be even greater.

2.5. Sports Events (12)

2.5.1. Feasibility 5

There are several locales for different sport events however it could be difficult to fit a lot of people depending on the sport (Ping pong, Badminton, Paddle).

For Locales we've got **Boulgner Park** with ample space for different activities.

Skövde Arena is also an option for water sports.

Skövde kommun has several sports facilities that can be booked.

For each event a referee is guaranteed to be needed, as well as a host. It can be expected to have a minimum of two people for this event with a varying maximum depending on the sport.

The expected biggest cost will be the locale and possibly personnel, depending on the sport equipment might be needed to be bought for the event. The cost can vary from low to high depending on the sport. The equipment might be able to be covered by a sports organisation in Skövde if our sport matches theirs and we can reach an agreement.

2.5.2. Interest Level 7

Due to the lack of physically active events it can be expected that this is an untapped market that could bring new guests to our events. However neither do we know how large the market is for a sports event.

It's believed that we can have cheap tickets as the main cost will be the locale fee.

The interest will vary greatly depending on the sport chosen for the event. If it's well known it can be expected that more people will show up, especially if it's a popular sport. We can also expect more people to show up if it's an easy sport to understand

2.6. Beach Volleyball (16)

2.6.1. Feasibility 8

Skövde kommun has sports facilities that possibly will have volleyball net and accompanying ball.

Otherwise **Boulogner park**, by the lake in the sand is the locale most fitting for this type of event.

Depending on the size of the locale the people needed could vary from two to four. Mostly depending on how many active games there are at once as each will need a referee.

After a short look through the storage inventory I could not find any volleyball nets or balls, however a more thorough look is in order if we decide to do this kind of event. It can be assumed that renting a locale will be the highest cost, if we decide on going with one of the facilities. Otherwise a cost for volleyball net and ball would be the main expenses.

2.6.2. Interest Level 8

Similarly to the sport events activity, the lack of competing physically active events can boost interest levels for this event.

If we manage to have this event at the lake, I believe it can greatly boost the interest for the event if done around summer with warm weather.

Since this sport is fairly common and usually taught at schools, it'd be easy for students to engage with the event.

Since our costs for this event is expected to be low, the tickets would be very cheap.

2.7. Outdoor Event (18)

2.7.1. Feasibility 9

As the name would imply the event is supposed to be held outside. This limits it in its choices of locales.

Boulogner Park is a great locale for this kind of event as it offers ample space and a spot for grilling if desired.

The people needed would vary depending on the amount of games on offer during the event. With a bare minimum of one person for each three games on offer.

The main cost for this event is expected to be buy-in of new outdoor games. As I checked out the storage I found the following items relevant to the event: Kubb, Frisbees, Hula hoops, Jumping rope, Tennis ball, Ping pong rackets.

However there might be more as I only looked on a surface level.

2.7.2. Interest Level 9

This event would give great freedom to the attendees to choose a game most fitting for themselves, however this choice and unstructured nature of the event could lead to a smaller turnout. Based on the attendees assumed uncertainty and with it anxiety.

The cost of entry would be able to range from zero and upwards, this would definitely attract more people.

The most similar event to this would be vitae vs skills, it is held annually and it's shown to attract a lot of guests. It can be assumed, with that event as a measuring stick, that there is an audience for these kinds of events.

2.8. Language Café with themes (15)

2.8.1. Feasibility 7

For a language café, a locale with decent spacing tables and comfortable chairs would be ideal.

Högskolan I Skövde has plenty of classrooms that we could possibly rent, they've got decent size however the atmosphere feels very academic.

Kårhuset Boulgner KB with either victoriasalen or stora salen, gives ample space decent chairs and tables.

Depending on the expected amount of guests we'd need varying amounts of people that speak several languages. Ideally we'd be able to have four different languages present.

Main cost would be renting of locale, however if done at either högskolan i skövde or KB, rent would be null.

2.8.2. Interest Level 8

Ideally the cost of entry for this event would be zero, and thus attract as many students as possible regardless of their economic situation.

We've noticed there are a lot more internationals than expected, if we're able to reach out to them, there could be high interest in this kind of event.

There's very few events in the same vein as this one, mostly hosted by people outside of SiS.

2.9. Movie Nights (20)

2.9.1. Feasibility 10

There is a movie room in **Högskolan I Skövde** that is already used for movie nights.

We'd need at most two people for this event, one to handle technical stuff and one to handle guests.

Since the cost of renting the room is zero, only snacks would be a cost.

2.9.2. Interest Level 10

There is already a fully established film club in skills that draws in a good amount of guests each month. Beyond that several other sections have also held movie nights, this abundance of events could hamper interest in a KS event. However the skills filmclub has poor reach and is mostly unknown outside of skills, a KS event would be able to reach people that haven't heard of Chills.

The cost of entry would be able to be zero, and we'd even be able to offer snacks.

2.10. Sleigh Race (9)

2.10.1. Feasibility 6

This event would have to take place in snow at a hill with a decent slope. None such places were found during this search.

We'd need at minimum three people to handle start, middle, and end of the race as referees.

The cost would be expected to be low as it's assumed only a permit is needed for usage of a hill if on public property. Other costs would include safety equipment and first aid.

2.10.2. Interest Level 3

To participate in the race guests would need to bring their own sleighs, this could be a large cost that most would be unwilling or unable to pay. This puts a huge dampener on the interest for this event.

The event's structure is inherently simple as it can be assumed everyone knows how to win a race.

There are very few similar events, both hosted in SiS and outside of SiS, as such it could be an appreciated novelty each winter.

2.11. Hike Trip (16)

2.11.1. Feasibility 8

A path would be needed or a destination, **Billinge Berg** could work splendidly with its beautiful nature and proximity.

Rånna Ryds Naturresevat could also work and would be easier on the guests with its kinder inclines.

We'd need a minimum of two people, preferable four, to guide the hike group through the wilderness.

To get the guests to the appropriate destinations, a bus would be required, water is also highly important for this event. These would be the main costs of the event and it's uncertain how high the cost for the buses would be; it can be expected to be in the thousands range.

2.11.2. Interest Level 8

There is already a group hosting and handling hike events, THRILLS, it seems to go well for their events. It would be advised to go to different spots than THRILLS to appeal to those who like hiking but want to see new places each time.

The cost for tickets can be assumed to be able to be priced around THRILLS ranges and thus we ought to expect the same amount of guests.

2.12. Treasure Hunt (10)

2.12.1. Feasibility 4

For this kind of event a large locale would be needed, lest it become an escape room.

Högskolan i Skövde's campus could prove to be a viable area, as well as familiar to all students attending.

Boulogner Park with it's ample area could grant several hiding places, however the open lines of sight necessitated that the treasure be well hidden.

Several locales aiming for a cooperation with other organizations or business could greatly expand the play area while opening up possibilities for sponsorships. This is however the most time heavy option planning wise.

For the event a minimum of two people would be preferred, one to place clues/treasures around the play area and one to maintain a station to receive the winners.

The main cost would assumedly be the treasure, or the cost for renting for the area/locales.

2.12.2. Interest Level 6

With very few similar events, especially ones on a grand scale, alongside the ease of participation. This event could garner high interest levels

The cost of entry is almost forced to be zero if the treasures are placed at public spaces as we would be unable to check if someone's paid before retrieving the treasure/clue.

Depending on the layout the event may be complex or simple. If it's several treasures spread out it will maintain its simplicity. If it's one treasure with clues leading to it, the clues could become a moment of frustration and complexity.

3. Conclusion

The rough estimates of feasibility and interest level should not be held as absolute, but rather as a start for discussion and evaluation of the ideas. However from these estimates we can summarise that most of these ideas are feasible and are within the capacity of the student union to host.

Across most of the ideas it's also been assumed that the students would be interested in most of them, High interest levels can be used as an estimate for how likely the event is to succeed/sell all tickets.

All these events could be done but it's ill-advised to do all of them within a year or two, as the time cost would be too great. It's therefore recommended to select an appropriate few events with the most promise, to further refine the ideas brought forth.

Borrowing contract for the camera and the following equipment

Studentkåren i Skövde (also known as the Student union in Skövde, abbreviated as SiS) rents out a camera and additional equipment to those who are kårengagerade- Under those terms that are listed in the contract below.

Definitions

- **Kårengagerade** - Are defined by those who are currently sitting in a board within Studentkåren i Skövde, and/or part of the election committee and/or elected as Evenemangsansvarig, Trivselansvarig and/or KBIT within Skövde Sexmästeri.
- **Kårstyrelseledamot** - Are defined by those who have been elected as section chairman and those who have been elected to the student union board at the stämmor (Grand assemblies) and are currently sitting their mandate.
- **Personnel** - Gemma & presidium.
- **Following equipment** - Is defined by what the borrower has checkmarked on the other side of this paper.

Who can sign the kårstyrelseledamot & personnel box:

- Those who are sitting as Kårstyrelseledamot and/or Personnel are allowed to sign the borrowed, and the returned paper.
 - It is highly recommended that the same person who signed the borrowed paper to sign the returned paper. As they are aware of what is being borrowed, however in case of said person not being available it is fine if someone else signs it.

The borrowers rights:

- To use the camera kit and the following equipment during the borrowing period.

The borrowers responsibilities:

- To return the camera kit and the following equipment at the end of the borrowing period.
 - If the camera kit and the following equipment is not to be returned at the end of the borrowing period, there will be a late fee to the borrower of [50kr] each day it has not been returned.
- To make sure the camera and the following equipment is to be returned in the same condition before it was borrowed with the exception of normal wear and tear.
- To contact Studentkåren i Skövde in case of any damage and/or loss of the camera kit and/or the following equipment.
 - In the case of theft and/or robbery a police report will be made in consultation with Studentkåren i Skövde, where Studentkåren i Skövde will make a decision on how the matter should be handled.
 - If the camera and/or the following equipment that has been borrowed is lost and/or damaged to the point it cannot be repaired and/or isn't covered by Studentkårens insurance. The borrower shall replace the full sum which corresponds to the replacement value. If the borrower cannot replace the full sum, it falls onto their section or equivalent.
- To make sure the camera is fully charged and memory card is emptied at the end of the borrowing period.
