Background: For the last Ovve-wednesday this spring, we'll be having it outside with a quiz walk. Ludvig has sent out a quiz template to the event officers. G-house is also booked in case of weather being bad.

Background: I've (Ludvig) created the PG for the graduation ball but right now we're only two people. It would be appreciated if more people wanted to help out.

11a. Bundle Prices for SköCraft patches

Background: I (Ludvig) wish to have a bundle price for some of the SköCraft patches, especially the hearts. I want this due to the large profit margin the hearts have when sold for the normal price.

Discussion:

The heart patches cost 25kr, a suggested bundle price is 3 for 40kr. If they are sold for 25kr and people buy them, it seems like a fair market price. Due to the fact we didn't buy them with this budget money, it could be good to still sell them for a bundle price, it's still profit. Another suggestion is to have a bundle price for Intro.

Another suggestion regarding price would be 50kr instead of 40kr as it becomes an odd price range. (You get one free if it would be 50kr). Ludvig will make a decision at the next meeting.

Discussion: Maisie presents the IC-committee budget. As it's a project group we don't need to necessarily vote on it, however IC-would like to present it for transparency. The plan is to go +- 0, even if the current budget currently expects to go -2.5k. It's quite difficult to make a proper budget due to the fact it's a new project group and how many will attend etc. A lot of this can be changed throughout the year and once the project plan is fully done, it can be more accurate.

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Q: Will the IC-committee hold any Intro events?

A: No, they'll only hold How to Högskola, because many people in the IC-committee are also part of other boards.

Q: What is the Ikea trip? Is it for an event?

A: It's an event where we'll take people to Ikea, so people don't have to bring their stuff on the train. Some people will drive, and others will take the train. Those who have paid will get a reserved spot in the trailer (unsure if it will cost.)

Q: 6232 - What does this account entail?

A: It's meant to cover the "Culture day", which is essentially an event where some people will cook food from their culture. It's not meant to be sold or anything.

Discussion:

Compared to the previous Hoodies, the current plan is to have "Studentkåren i Skövde" on the front side, and the Crane with the text "Studentkåren i Skövde" on the back. An option would be to have the crane on the side of the arms, however that would be an additional cost (per piece). The price is also based on the print size.

A question was raised regarding how would we like to market ourselves? Before we used to have the text "Kårengagerad" and people would be unsure what it meant until they saw the front. If we would change it, we would market the Student Union more instead of us being "Kårengagerade". If SiS would like to keep the kårengagerade text, then it could possibly be put on the front side.

It could also be a soft launch to check if people wish to buy hoodies in the future.

The board would like to see:

Studentkåren i Skövde text (without the crane) and the Crane on the back with "Studentkåren i Skövde" with the colour Navy. Skip on the Crane on the arm.

1. Basic Information

1.2 The Project

1.2.1 Scope of the Project

Atlas2 is a spex group that creates performing arts with students from July 1, 2025, to July 1, 2026. The project aims to continue the work that the sub-association Atlas2 carried out during its active period. If there is sufficient interest and engagement from students, Atlas2 will be developed into a sub-association again and will be able to organize large projects.

1.2.2 Connections with Other Organizations or Projects

The project aims to promote interest in performing arts among students. To achieve this, the project group will attempt to establish collaborations with Skövde Sexmästeri in order to stage a spex at the Student Union House, and with the Student Music Association in Skövde (SMS) with the purpose of enhancing Atlas2's performing arts with music.

2. General

2.1 Purpose

- To provide an opportunity for students at the University of Skövde to pursue their interest in performing arts and to promote students' social interactions.
- To contribute to Skövde's student culture and the social life of members under SiS.
- To strive to foster a creative environment among students.

2.2 Background

A spex group that provides students at the University of Skövde the opportunity to create performing arts for students, by students. The project aims to create and promote interest in performing arts among students and to maintain student culture.

2.3 Goals

The goals for Atlas2 25/26 are as follows:

- Create a stable project group.
- Explore the interest in performing arts.
- Prepare marketing materials during summer 2025. - **first post was on 9th of July, followed up by 2 more posts about the project before intro ht25 which were prepared during the summer**
- Create an Instagram account before the fall introduction 2025. - **Created in July 2025**
- **Market the project before and during the fall introduction 2025.**
- Participate in Tent Week 2025 with SMS to market and sell patches.
- Launch a synopsis competition directly after the fall introduction 2025 and appoint a winner, whose spex will be produced. - **competition was announced on september 8th**
- Create an ensemble to perform the spex. - **auditions were held on 1st of December and digital auditions were held open until 9th of January**

- Strive to hold a spex performance at the Student Union House Boulogner. - **Spex was held on the 25th of March at KB**
- Charge for tickets to the performance to further fund the project. - **PG charged for tickets (80kr/students and 100kr/non-students) and sold out and has therefore gotten the approval to save up the savings from the project for the association for the budget year 25/26**

2.3.1 Priority of Project Goal

Create a project group. To develop the project, a project group is required to work on it continuously. The project group is responsible for driving the project forward and involving students.

Promote student interest in performing arts and create an opportunity for them to engage in it.

3. Organization

3.1.1 Project Role Holders

Client: Student Union in Skövde

Project Owner: Student Union in Skövde

Steering Committee: Project group assembled by the project leader with oversight from the Student Union Board in Skövde.

Major decisions regarding, for example, budget and project plan are made by the Student Union Board in Skövde.

Project Management (Spex General): Noor Al-sanatee

Based on the decisions made by the Student Union Board, the project leader has the mandate to lead a project group and drive the project to completion. In the absence of the project leader, the Union Board will appoint a new one or act as project leader.

Project Group: The project group has three defined and appointed roles as follows:

Reference Groups: Student Music Association in Skövde (SMS) and Skövde Sexmästeri.

3.2 Responsibilities and Authority

The project leader is responsible for ensuring that the project is carried out in accordance with the set goals. The project leader is also responsible for:

- Being well informed about the finances of Atlas2
- Having overall responsibility for the project group
- Working with the treasurer to create a budget
- Being responsible for sending out meeting invitations and establishing agendas for project group meetings
- Having the right to approve agreements on behalf of the project
- Having the right to make purchases

- Regularly reporting to the Union Board about the project's activities

4. Anchoring and Requirements

The project group is responsible for maintaining good communication with the Union Board and other functions within the Student Union in Skövde.

5. Schedule and Resource Needs

5.1 Project Schedule

From the appointment of the project group, detailed planning for the operating year begins. The project group will prepare marketing materials and contact companies and associations to develop the project.

During the 2025 introduction, the project group will attend the SMS tent on campus and socialize with students. This way, the project will be marketed and recruit members. In September, after the introduction, a synopsis competition will be launched on Atlas2's social media and the project group will appoint a winner. The winner of the synopsis competition will become the scriptwriter and receive a deadline for when the script must be completed, typically 3–5 weeks after being chosen. Meanwhile, an ensemble consisting of Atlas2 members will be formed, and the rehearsal period begins once the script is finalized. A spex should be held in February at the Student Union House, and tickets should be released 3–4 weeks before the performance.

5.2 Resource Needs

5.2.1 Spaces and Facilities

Throughout the project, spaces are needed for rehearsals and project group meetings. Project group meetings will be held on campus or in the Student Union's facilities depending on availability. The project group is responsible for finding rehearsal spaces. The ensemble should primarily rehearse in facilities on campus.

5.2.2 Training

No training will be provided to the project group or project members. The project group will have access to information shared in the common Google Drive folder.

6. Working Methods

6.1 Document Management

Documents important to the project group will be available in a Google Drive folder linked to the Atlas2 Google account. Meetings are recorded in minutes, and the minutes will be available in the folder. All members of the project group should have access to the folder. The Union Board may request access to any documents or folders via a shared link.

6.2 Administrative Functions

The project leader is responsible for regularly updating and revising documents. The project leader is also responsible for regularly reporting to the Union Board on the progress of the project.

6.3 Invoicing

The project leader, together with the treasurer, is responsible for collecting invoicing data. The information required for invoicing includes: - **no invoicing has been done by the projectgroup. Only invoices paid were to skösex and some purchases for mascot, pizza, snacks for celebration etc.**

- Name of the company/organization
- Name of the contact person
- Organization number
- Invoice address

In connection with this, it must also be documented what each company/organization is to be invoiced for and how much they are to pay. It is the responsibility of the project leader and treasurer to compile this information and submit a complete invoicing document to the Financial Manager of the Student Union in Skövde within one week of the booked time. Invoicing must be completed no later than 01/07/2026, i.e., before the project leader's mandate expires.

7. Risks

The following are risks that may affect goal achievement and outcomes:

- **Low student engagement - A total of 10 actors auditioned to be in the spex and made it. Except for the 10 actors, 5 responsables have been elected to Atlas2 (2 music, 2 scriptwriters/directors, 1 choreographer, 1 dance-club). Atlas2 also managed to start up an orchestra with SMS that performed at the spex, with approximately 15members. That is a total of 30 students engaged in the project, not counting the PG and the skösex workers that provided assistance with sound and lights. Most of these students had not been involved in the student union before.**

8. Budget

9. Follow-up

When the project is completed, the project leader must submit a written follow-up, partly based on the structure of the project plan. The follow-up will highlight what went well, what went less well, and what might be good to consider if the project is developed into a sub-association. Budget follow-up will be presented by the spex general and the treasurer.

During the course of the project, the responsibility lies with the spex general to assess whether there is a need to develop the project into a sub-association. If student interest is present, the project may be further developed upon approval by the Union Board.

Follow up by the project leader:

As the spexgeneral of Atlas² throughout the mandate period of the project group, which was from 1st of July 2025 until 1st of July 2026, I will evaluate how the process of the project has gone.

The goals of Atlas2 were to create a stable project group. This has been partially accomplished as the project group had one dropout of a board member in November 2025. It has been going well for the bigger parts, with minor concerns of board members having to settle into the roles of the project. That has been assessed by the spexgeneral having talks with the project group to make sure that all members are being supported equally in the work put towards the project.

We have been able to explore students' interest in performing arts by offering a space for students that have an interest for performance to be able to express it within the student union. A total of 30 students participated in the project outside of the project group and skösex workers, where more than 60% of the students were totally new to participation within the student union. Some students had memberships already but had not joined any project or association under SiS before. Excluding the 30 participating students, the spex sold over 100 tickets for the spex which offered exploring the interest in performing arts for the audience as well. Overall, this goal is considered to be met successfully. For the upcoming years of the association it is important that Atlas² is continuously being promoted to students, especially during the introduction weeks. It is expected that they attend Ovve-wednesdays, as this project group has tried to keep the social media active to reach out to students.

The marketing by the project group started getting prepared during the summer of 2025, where the board started the planning of the promotion during the introduction weeks. An Instagram account, a Facebook account and a Discord channel were all created to reach out to students on different platforms. Marketing materials, such as a short spex was prepared and performed twice during section-sitting during the introduction to further promote the project outside of digital platforms as well. The project group also attended the SMS-tent during the introduction to reach out to students and to sell patches to finance the project. This was only possible to do for three days out of five days that the tent was up, as most of the project members were active in sectionboard as well and had to spend time in the section tents. This could be improved next year to make sure that Atlas² can be promoted throughout the whole tent week and would rely on board members making the time for it.

The synopsis competition was announced on September 8th to promote it and give students time after the introduction to send in their ideas. The launching of this was successful, which was the goal of the project. However, only two synopsis were sent in which can be improved next year by promoting the competition more during the introduction. This could also be improved on by more clear instructions given out, which would be decided on the next board of Atlas². A winner was chosen but they did not wish to write the script, therefore two other scriptwriters were chosen based on group interviews named "scriptwriters/directors forum". Students were

invited to these to read the synopses, express their opinions and ideas as well as introduce themselves to the board.

An ensemble was created together with the directors, who were also the scriptwriters as well as the board and music responsables. The actors were chosen by the directors and board members but got appointed roles based on the directors choices. The music responsables were in charge of finding musicians for the orchestra. Knowledge of playing an instrument was needed for the orchestra. The actors however did not need any prior experience or knowledge as a lot of acting-practice was done during the rehearsals.

The spex performance was originally set to be performed in February, which was considered too soon after the winter break and was therefore pushed to March. This decision was made based on the need of at least two full months of rehearsals and many participating students were not in the city before mid-January. This seemed to be appreciated by both the responsables as well as the board. Some actors did mention in the feedback that the spex was performed during an exam-period and after discussion with the board, the spex could possibly be performed a week earlier by mid-March but we could not find another appropriate time period for it.

The ticket cost was decided by the board after discussion with the responsables. The responsables were aiming for the tickets to be sold at 75kr, which the board considered too cheap to be able to fund the project further. Therefore a compromise was made and the tickets sold for 80kr for students and 100kr for non-students. A total of 127 tickets were sold through Orbi and through Izettle in the entry to KB. It was not ideal to sell tickets through Orbi because of the worry of it not attracting non-students. Therefore, other ways of selling the tickets were attempted by contacting the university and Next Skövde for help. No response was received and the project group settled for selling tickets by the entrance instead, which was not ideal and alternative ways should be looked into for next year's spex. However 35 non-student tickets were sold through Orbi which was the total of non-students attending and was considered successful for this spex.

Overall the spex and the process towards it was successful with minor challenges along the way. To further improve Atlas² it is important to market the association throughout the whole year and attract students to it. This is considered a space for students that have an interest in performance arts to find a community during their study time at Högskolan i Skövde and to promote the student culture of spex. An additional spex was held as a collaboration with Skösex during the Skösex gasque on 17th of April. More collaborations are encouraged with all parts of the Student Union and that will be included in the handovers for the next board.
